

**Beaverton School District Parent and Student Exemption From Instruction (Opt-Out) Notice  
Middle School & High School**

According to OAR 581-022-1440 (2), each school district shall teach age-appropriate, comprehensive sexuality education, HIV/AIDS and STD prevention in elementary and secondary schools. Please take notice that pursuant to Oregon Compiled Laws regarding Comprehensive Sexuality Education including Erin’s Law [OAR 581-022-1440 (5), ORS 336.455, ORS 336.035(2)], parents may request that their child be excused and exempted, for the current school year (see request date below), from the following school instruction and/or activities. An alternative assignment will be provided.
